The Campus SafeWalk (CSW) program is a student and employee (SafeWalker) driven service dedicated to reducing the risk of physical and/or emotional harm to all NorQuesters on the move. Our SafeWalkers contribute to a safe and healthy Campus between the hours of 4:15 pm to last call at 9:15 pm during the Fall and Winter Terms, ensuring that everyone who accesses the CSW program gets to their respective vehicles, the Corona LRT station or select bus-stops with a peace of mind.

CSW is a fantastic way to meet new people and build relationships. We offer flexible shifts that you can choose from daily, **a minimum of 3 hours per shift**. As part of the SafeWalker team, you will never be alone. There will always be a two-person team on site during operating hours. The CSW SafeWalker program offers Mandatory Orientation with program Facilitator and Service Manager, Students' Association of NorQuest College (SANQC) on-boarding, and Security training with NorQuest College security team.

No matter your size, ethnicity, gender, or background, you are eligible to apply for the CSW SafeWalker opportunity.
