(Article 9).</li> <li>• We received 30 applications, and 4 candidates were short listed for interviews.</li> <li>• Two of the candidates were determined not to be a fit for the role.</li> <li>• Ultimately, we found that Wanda had more confidence in the next steps of implementing the new policy details and working with the DRO role. She is excited at the potential opportunity to create an elections committee and is already hopeful to have a chance at continuing working with SANQC for future election cycles if Council likes her work.</li> <li>•</li> </ul>
